## CARE SHEET

**JND Furniture** is designed and built specifically for outdoor use.

All JND Furniture comes with a 5-year structural warranty for your peace of mind.

With regular care, your furniture will continue to look and perform at its best for years to come. All furniture is finished with a durable exterior coating.

As with all natural timber, ongoing exposure to weather may gradually cause the surface to grey over time.

To preserve the timber's appearance and provide continued protection, we recommend re-coating with the same oil or lacquer once or twice annually, depending on environmental conditions.



### Timber Maintenance

All timbers require re-oiling once to twice per year to refresh and protect the surface, particularly when furniture is fully exposed to the elements and not undercover. Please refer to our recommended oils and varnishes for the specific timbers used on your furniture.

Merbau - Leaching of tannin, sometimes referred to as bleeding, can occur in Merbau timber and sometimes with Spotted Gum also. This is a natural process and is often more noticeable on light-coloured frames, decking, or paving.

Tannin is a naturally occurring substance in timber and may leach out during the first few exposures to water. This can temporarily stain light-coloured surfaces.

To remove tannin residue, gently wipe the affected area with a soft sponge or cloth using a mild soap and water solution. If tannin is left for an extended period, staining may become more difficult to remove, particularly on lighter surfaces.

When using black stain, it is recommended that outdoor furniture is not stacked.

### Cleaning

To clean your furniture, use a mild soap and water solution. A small amount of dishwashing liquid mixed with water in a spray bottle works well. Lightly spray the surface and wipe clean using a soft, non-abrasive cloth.

For heavier or stubborn stains, a degreaser suitable for hardwoods or decking may be used. We recommend Aqualis Deck Bright Cleaner for removing dirt, grime, and oil stains, as well as for brightening the timber.

### Leg Caps

All tables and benches are fitted with protective leg caps. To prevent premature wear, avoid dragging tables or benches when moving them, particularly on rough or abrasive surfaces, as this may cause the caps to wear more quickly. Replacement leg caps are available for purchase and can be posted upon request.



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### **Powder Coated Frame Care and Maintenance**

Rough handling of powder coated furniture may result in chipping of the coated surface. Damage caused in this way is not covered under warranty.

To maintain the finish, regularly wipe down frames using clean water and a soft cloth. Always rinse thoroughly with water to remove any remaining detergent.

Avoid steam cleaning, pressure washing, steel brushes or steel wool, and cleaners containing chlorine. Do not dry dust, as this may scratch the surface. Never use strong or aggressive solvents on powder coated finishes. Products such as turpentine, white spirits, thinners, and similar solvents can damage the coating and reduce its lifespan.

Touch-up paint is available for purchase. Minor scratches should be repaired as soon as they appear to help prevent further damage.

### **Lockable Castor Wheels**

JND Furniture is fitted with commercial-grade lockable castor wheels, securely bolted in place with two bolts per wheel. Each castor is rated to support up to 52 kg, providing a total load capacity of over 200 kg per table.

Avoid knocking or dragging wheels over steps, as this may cause damage. When moving furniture up or down a step or level, it is recommended that the furniture is carefully lifted rather than rolled.

Regular visual inspections should be carried out to ensure the castors remain secure and have not loosened or de-threaded. If any looseness is detected, the bolts should be re-tightened promptly.

Replacement castor wheels are available for purchase. Installation may incur a call-out fee.

### **ModWood Care and Maintenance**

ModWood is a composite product made from a blend of ground sustainable wood waste and recycled plastic.

Regular cleaning is essential to keep ModWood looking its best. Do not use high-pressure or pressure cleaners on ModWood, as this may damage the surface. Stubborn stains, particularly oil-based stains, may be difficult to remove. For these types of stains, we recommend using a suitable degreaser such as Kenco or Aqualis Composite Bright.

For added protection, Deck Protect Composite Sealer can be applied. This sealer may be reapplied to areas that are subject to higher levels of oil and fat exposure. Strong chemicals should be used with caution and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

### **Ekodeck Designer Series Care and Maintenance**

Ekodeck Designer Series is not a self-cleaning product and requires periodic cleaning, particularly in undercover or alfresco areas. Cleaning requirements will vary depending on how the product is used and the level of weather exposure. Ekodeck Designer Series may stain if not cleaned regularly. For general cleaning, we recommend using a microfibre cloth with a diluted mixture of dishwashing liquid and hot water, followed by a thorough rinse.

While Ekodeck Designer Series' DuraShell™ coating is resistant to most stains, we recommend removing foreign substances as soon as possible to reduce the risk of staining or discolouration. If general cleaning does not remove stubborn stains, the use of a stain remover may be required. For oil-based stains, we recommend an aerosol car or engine degreaser. Spray the affected area and gently scrub with a microfibre cloth, then follow with a general clean to remove any remaining residue.
